

## Dane County Farmers' Market Scholarship Application

The Dane County Farmers Market (DCFM) is offering multiple scholarships to students studying agriculture or any agriculture related subject area. Students enrolled in two- or four-year programs are eligible to apply. Scholarship recipients will receive a \$1000.00 scholarship. The scholarship will be **payable, toward tuition**, to the school the recipient is attending-one half in the fall semester 2025, and one half in the spring semester 2026. Payment of the scholarship each semester will be contingent on the continuing school eligibility criteria. You can only receive this scholarship once.

The completed application must be received (emailed or postmarked) by the DCFM Scholarship Committee by **February 1, 2025**. Scholarship recipients will be notified no later than April 15, 2025.

### Requirements

- Recipient should be planning on choosing a major or a minor in an agricultural science or in an agriculture related field.
- Recipient should have a minimum 3.0 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be accepted to a program or continuing for the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 school year.
- Demonstrated interest or experience in local food production or markets is preferred.
- Applications must be received by February 1, 2025.
